Bed bugs - Bed bug encounters can seriously impact an establishment's reputation and can potentially lead to liability claims or legal action.



Cockroaches - These pests can contaminate food and surfaces and may carry pathogens such as *E. coli* and *Salmonella*.



Rodents - Mice and rats may carry disease-causing pathogens and can contaminate food and surfaces. They can also damage equipment, wiring, and structures.



Birds - Droppings can be a slip and fall hazard and may contain harmful pathogens. Nesting materials and feathers can damage equipment and pose a potential fire risk.



Flies - Flies are known vectors of disease and can potentially spread pathogens wherever they land.



Ants - Ants can contaminate food and surfaces. Some species can inflict bites and stings. Others can infest equipment that may cause electrical disruptions.
